



GRILL & ACCESSORY COVER

Model # AOB24, AOB30, AOB36,
AOC24, AOC30, AOC36,
AOB2SB

INSTALLER: Leave these instructions
with consumer.
CONSUMER: Retain for future reference.



This cover is for use with your American Outdoor Grill product. It is constructed of a durable material that will protect your appliance when not in use.

BUILT-IN COVER AOB(24,30,36)

1. Place the cover over your unit, with the AOG logo facing forward.
2. Pull the front portion of the cover (lined with elastic) under the front face of the unit.

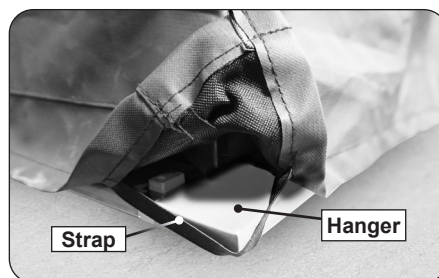


Fig. 1-1 Strap detail

3. Hook the left and right straps under the notches of the unit's rear hanger. See Fig. 1-1 for an example.

SIDE BURNER COVER AOB2SB

1. Place the cover over the lid of your unit, with the AOG logo facing up.
2. Hook the left and right straps under the notches of the unit's rear hanger. See Fig. 1-1 for an example.
3. Then, take the bottom hooks (found on the front most corners of the cover) and hook them under the bottom corners of the face frame as shown in Fig. 1-2.

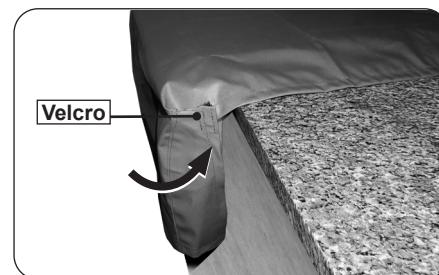


Fig. 1-3 Side burner cover sidewall protection

4. Fold the cover top corners inward, then secure the Velcro on the left and right sides so the flaps fold over to protect the front face panel sidewalls. See Fig. 1-3.

PORTABLE COVER AOC(24,30,36)

1. Fold down the left and right shelves and place the cover over your unit with the AOG logo facing forward as shown in Fig. 1-4.

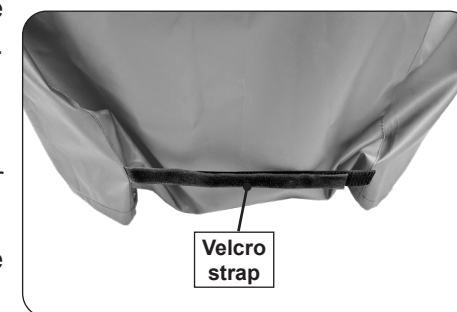


Fig. 1-5 Strap detail

2. The cover is equipped with Velcro strips. They may be used to secure the lower skirt portion of the cover. See Fig. 1-5.

CLEANING

Use mild hand soap with warm water and a sponge.

It is recommended that you wash the cover only as needed.

To prevent mold and mildew: wipe down and dry your cover with a soft towel or cloth after cleaning or rainfall.
