## Digital Thermometer/Thermostat Replacement

(Under glass touch controlled)

**INSTALLER:** Leave these instructions with consumer.

**CONSUMER:** Retain for future reference.

This digital thermometer/thermostat is only for replacement on Fire Magic grills (gas and electric) and pizza ovens <u>equipped</u> <u>with under glass digital touch thermometer/thermostats</u>.

## INSTALLATION

Installation on an EL500 Electric Grill is demonstrated here.

- 1. Be sure the unit is completely cool, the gas is shut off and control knobs are in the OFF position (if applicable), and the power supply is disconnected.
- **2.** Open the control panel. Refer to the appliance owner's manual for complete steps.




Fig. 1-1 Disconnect wires

- 3. Locate the digital thermometer/thermostat and disconnect the thermocouple and power source input connectors (see Fig. 1-1).
- **4.** Remove the four securing nuts using an <sup>11</sup>/<sub>32</sub>" wrench (see Fig. 1-2).




Fig. 1-3 Remove digital thermometer/thermostat

- **5.** Gently lift off the digital thermometer/thermostat (see Fig. 1-3) and discard appropriately.
- **6.** Take the <u>new digital thermometer/thermostat</u> and apply a layer of dielectric grease (provided with this kit) to the same two connectors as previously disconnected from the old thermometer/thermostat.




Fig. 1-4 Peel off protective film

- **7.** Then peel off the protective film from the front side (see Fig. 1-4).
- **8.** Place/align the new thermometer/thermostat flush against the glass, and secure using the nuts previously removed.
- **9.** Connect the thermocouple and power source input connectors.
- **10.** Reinstall the control panel and test the unit.
